

Protocol for Play at Kidlington Forum Pavilion during Covid 19 Restrictions in 2022

1. All players shall be paid up members of their clubs and members of Table Tennis England. Players in competitions shall be compete or compete plus members of Table Tennis England;
2. Players shall wait until the supervisor has made the Pavilion safe for play before entering;
3. **Players shall exercise social distancing when waiting to enter, when leaving and at all times in the Pavilion. Social distancing shall be staying 1 metre from any other person and wearing a mask;**
4. **Players shall not enter if the supervisor advises you not to because you display possible symptoms of coronavirus infection. The supervisor may take your temperature in order to check symptoms or may require you to take a test;**
5. Players are advised to take a lateral flow test before attending a session;
6. **Players shall not attend if they have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for covid and is isolating;**
7. **Players shall use the hand sanitiser provided in the entrance hall;**
8. Players shall have booked for the session they attend;
9. Supervisors will check the booking system for their sessions to ensure only members who have booked attend;
10. Players shall not take a shower;
11. Only one person at a time may use the toilet;
12. **Players shall be allocated to play on a specific table or tables by the supervisor and shall not play on any other table;**
13. Players shall come ready to play and shall keep their own bags in their own playing area on the floor and not on the chairs;
14. **Masks shall be worn at all times except when playing, officiating or coaching;**
15. **Masks shall NOT be worn during play;**
16. No more than 4 tables shall be used at any session;

17. Eight chairs shall be set out at each end of the Hall for any club session, at least 1 metre apart, and shall be allocated to specific players by the supervisor;
18. The scoring tables and scoreboards shall only be used for League matches;
19. League matches, or any other competition matches organised by ODTTA, will be on a maximum of 3 tables on any match night, separated by barriers, and players shall remain in their playing areas with their own chairs once play starts. They may use scoring tables. They will otherwise follow this protocol;
20. Both doors to the Hall shall remain open to maximise ventilation. Barriers can be erected in front of them to prevent balls leaving the playing area but allowing players to access. The door and/or windows at the kitchen end of the Hall shall also be opened;
21. The kitchen shall not be used except during League Matches or if safety equipment stored there is needed;
22. Players shall return balls from other games entering their areas by means other than handling them;
23. Players shall not enter the playing area unless advised by the supervisor;
24. Players shall follow any other instruction given by the supervisor;
25. At the end of all sessions tables and barriers shall be sanitised and returned to the store room;
26. Players shall leave the Pavilion promptly after finishing playing;
- 27. If supervisors' requests to comply with the risk assessment or protocol are ignored by a player they will be asked to leave AND SHALL DO SO. They will be warned that a future repeated breach will result in the player being banned from the club;**
28. Supervisors shall ensure waste is emptied into the main bin in the entrance hall;
29. Supervisors shall set the alarm and lock up the Pavilion once all players have left;
- 30. If any player contracts coronavirus infection within 2 weeks of playing at the Pavilion they shall notify Karl Bushell on 07833 338292 who will inform the Parish Council in order to implement track and trace procedures;**
31. The Kidlington Forum Table Tennis Club Committee reserves the right to close the Pavilion, or close it as required by the Parish Council, in order for it to be cleaned adequately prior to any further play.
